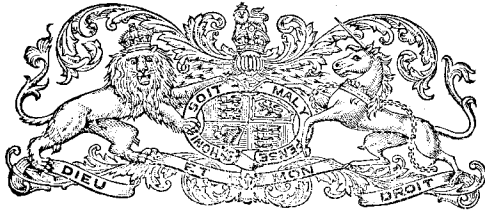

## KING'S REGULATION

TO AMEND THE SOLOMONS LICENCE REGULATION 1916.

Made by His Britannic Majesty's High Commissioner for the Western Pacific under the provisions of the Pacific Order in Council 1893.

In the name of His Majesty, GEORGE THE FIFTH, by the Grace of God of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Ireland and of the British Dominions beyond the Seas King, Defender of the Faith, Emperor of India.

1. This Regulation may be cited for all purposes as the Solomons Licence Amendment Regulation 1920. SHORT TITLE.

2. Sub-head (IV) of Schedule B of the Solomons Licence Regulation 1916 (hereinafter called the principal Regulation) is hereby amended and shall be read as if the following words were added thereto: AMENDMENT OF SUBHEAD (IV) OF SCHEDULE B TO REGULATION NO. 6 OF 1916.

“ Provided that where a vessel is employed in trading solely as a common carrier the person so employing such vessel shall in lieu of such licence fee pay the sum of fifteen pounds for every entry of such vessel.”

3. Sub-head (V) of Schedule B to the principal Regulation is hereby amended and shall be read as if the words “ other than a passenger steamer in respect of which a trading licence has been taken out ” were inserted between the word “ vessel ” and the word “ for ” in the first line thereof. AMENDMENT OF SUBHEAD (V) OF SCHEDULE B OF REGULATION NO. 6 OF 1916.
