AN ACT

TO APPROPRIATE A SUM OF ONE BILLION AND ONE HUNDRED AND TWENTY
THREE MILLION, THREE HUNDRED AND NINETY THREE THOUSAND
AND FIVE HUNDRED DOLLARS TO THE SERVICE OF THE YEAR ENDING
31 DECEMBER 2002 AND FOR RELATED MATTERS

ENACTED by the Parliament of the Fiji Islands—

Short title

1. This Act may be cited as the 2002 Appropriation Act 2001.

Appropriation of \$1,123,393,500

2. A sum of \$1,123,393,500 is to be issued from the Consolidated Fund or other funds of the State, and applied to the service of the year ending 31st December 2002 and such sum is to be appropriated for the purposes as specified in Schedules I and II.
