

RULES MADE UNDER SECTION 9 OF THE
SOLOMONS PATENT REGULATION 1917.

1. These Rules may be cited as the Solomons Patent Rules, 1917.

2. A Petition under the Solomons Patent Regulation 1917 shall be, as nearly as may be, in the Form contained in the First Schedule of these Rules.

3. The Fees to be paid under the said Regulation shall be those specified in the Second Schedule to these Rules.

4. The Resident Commissioner shall enter in the Patent Register with respect to each application :—

- (a) The number and year of the Letters Patent in the United Kingdom.
- (b) The number and date of the grant made under the said Regulation and the name of the grantee.
- (c) Particulars showing the nature of any document filed, the date thereof and the parties thereto.

FIRST SCHEDULE.
