**AN ORDINANCE**

TO MAKE PROVISION FOR THE RECOGNITION OF COIN OF THE GILBERT ISLANDS ISSUED UNDER THE COINAGE ORDINANCE (NO. 15 OF 1975) AS LEGAL TENDER IN ADDITION TO COIN WHICH IS LEGAL TENDER BY VIRTUE OF ITS STATUS AS SUCH IN THE COMMONWEALTH OF AUSTRALIA, AND TO MAKE PROVISION CONSEQUENTIAL THEREON AND IN CONNECTION THEREWITH BY AMENDMENT TO THE CURRENCY ORDINANCE (CHAPTER 50 OF THE LAWS).

Commencement: 1979

ENACTED by the Governor with the advice and consent of the House of Assembly:-

This Ordinance may be cited as the Currency (Legal Tender of Coinage) (Amendment) Ordinance 1979, and shall come into operation on such date as the Minister may by notice in the Gazette appoint.

Short title and commencement

This Ordinance shall be read and construed as one with the Coinage Ordinance.

Interpretation No. 15 of 1975

(1) Section 3 of the Currency Ordinance is amended in subsection (2):

Amendment of section 3(2) of CAR 50

(a) by inserting after the words "the Commonwealth of Australia", the words "or by virtue of regulations made by the Commissioner of Currency under the Coinage Ordinance 1975";

(b) by inserting after the words "the said Commonwealth", the words "or by virtue of the said regulations".

(2) Section 3 of the Currency Ordinance is amended in subsection (3) by inserting after the words "the least current weight of such coin", the words "under the said regulations or".
