MARRIAGE OF BRITISH SUBJECTS (FACILITIES).

AN ACT TO FACILITATE MARRIAGES BETWEEN BRITISH SUBJECTS  
RESIDENT IN SOLOMON ISLANDS AND BRITISH SUBJECTS  
RESIDENT IN THE UNITED KINGDOM. 2 of 1917

[13th February 1917]

1. This Act may be cited for all purposes as the Marriage of  
British Subjects (Facilities) Act. Short title

2. Where a marriage is intended to be solemnised or  
contracted in the United Kingdom between a British subject  
resident there, and a British subject resident in Solomon Islands,  
a certificate for marriage may be issued in Solomon Islands by a  
Registrar of Marriages appointed under the Pacific Islands Civil  
Marriages Order in Council 1907, in the like manner as if the  
marriage was to be solemnised or contracted under circum-  
stances requiring the issue of such certificate and as if both such  
British subjects were resident in Solomon Islands. Issue of
