An Act To appropriate twenty two million thirty six thousand two hundred and sixty seven dollars and eighty cents for the service of the year ending 31st December 1992.

ENACTED By the National Parliament of Solomon Islands.

- Short title. 1. This Act may be cited as the 1992 Supplementary Appropriation Act, (No. 2) 1992
- Authorised of issue from the Consolidated Fund of \$22,036,267.88 to the service of 1992. 2. The issue from the Consolidated Fund is hereby authorised of a sum of twenty-two million, thirty-six thousand two hundred and sixty-seven dollars eighty-eight cents to be applied to the service of the year ending 31st December 1992.
- Appropriation. 3. The sum specified in the preceding section shall be appropriated for the supply of the Heads specified, and in the amounts respectively
- Schedule. specified in relation thereto, in the First Schedule.
