AN ACT TO AMEND THE CRIMINAL PROCEDURE CODE ACT (CAP. 7) AND

**CRIMINAL PROCEDURE CODE
(AMENDMENT) ACT 2009**

Citation and
commencement

1. This Act may be cited as the Criminal Procedure Code (Amendment) Act 2009, and commences on the day appointed by the Minister, by notice in the *Gazette*.

Section 4
amended

2. Section 4 of the principal Act is amended in paragraph (c)(ii), by deleting “two hundred dollars” and substituting “10,000 penalty units”.

Section 7
amended

3. Section 7 of the principal Act is amended –

- (a) in subsection (1)(b), by deleting “one thousand dollars” and substituting “50,000 penalty units”; and
- (b) in subsection (2)(b), by deleting “two hundred dollars” and substituting “10,000 penalty units”.

Consequential
amendment

4. Section 27 of the Magistrates’ Courts Act (Cap. 20) is amended –

- (a) in sub-paragraph (ii) of the proviso to subsection (1)(b), by deleting “one thousand dollars” and substituting “50,000 penalty units”;
 - (b) in subsection (2)(a)(ii), by deleting “two hundred dollars” and substituting “10,000 penalty units”.
