



AN ACT to amend the Immigration Act 1978.

ENACTED by the National Parliament of Solomon Islands.

Short title.

1. This Act may be cited as the Immigration (Amendment) Act 1988.

Amendment
of Act No. 27
of 1978.

2. Section 2 of the Immigration Act 1978 is amended in the definition of the word "visitor" by omitting the words "two months" and by inserting instead the words "three months".
