**PRICE CONTROL ACT
(Cap. 64)****THE PRICE CONTROL (APPLICATION TO GOODS AND
RESTRICTION OF PRICES) (AMENDMENT) (NO.7) ORDER 2003.**

IN exercise of the powers conferred by sections 4 and 6 of the Price Control Act, and after consultations with the Prices Advisory Committee, I, TREVOR OLAVAE, Minister of Commerce, Employment and Trade, do hereby make the following Order -

1. This Order may be cited as the Price Control (Application to Goods and Restriction of Prices) (Amendment) (No.7) Order 2003 and shall come into operation on 3 September 2003.
2. Schedule 3 to the Price Control (Application to Goods and Restriction of Prices) Order 1987* is hereby amended by deleting serial No.13 thereof and substituting therefor the following -

“13 PETROLEUM PRODUCTS

	WHOLESALE (maximum price in cents per litre)	RETAIL (maximum price in cents per litre)
(a) Petroleum Motor Spirit		
	-(PMS) 269.12	334.5
(b) Distillate	-(ADO) 241.90	303.2
(c) Kerosene	-(KERO) 232.82	(maximum percentage mark - up)
		-cost into store plus 15% for sales of packaged product
		-cost into store plus 20% for break-bulk sales.”

**PROVINCIAL GOVERNMENT ACT 1997
(No. 7 of 1997)**

**THE TEMOTU PROVINCE BUSINESS LICENCE (AMENDMENT)
ORDINANCE 2003**

AN ORDINANCE to amend the Temotu Province Business Licence Ordinance 1992

Title and Commencement	1.	This Ordinance shall be cited as the Temotu Province Business Licence (Amendment) Ordinance 2003 and shall come into force on the day assented to by the Minister pursuant to Section 30 of the Provincial Government Act 1997.
To s.2	2.	Deleting the definition “Logging Sales”.
To s.7	3.	Section 7 of the principal ordinance is deleted.
To s.11	4.	Section 11 of the principal ordinance is amended by deleting the words “other than a Logging Sale Business”.
To s.18(2)	5.	Section 18(2) of the principal ordinance is amended deleting the words “other than a Logging Sales Business”.
To s.19(1)	6.	Section 19(i) of the principal ordinance is deleted.
To Schedule 2	7.	By deleting “Timber felling”.
To Schedule 2	8.	To insert a new category of business as follows:

“Forest Produce Felling trees for sale including the sale of all “forest produce” as defined in Part 1 section 2 of the Forest Resources and Timber Utilisation Act”.

s.22 9. Inserting a new section 22A as follows:

“DELEGATION OF POWERS BY EXECUTIVE

- (i) The Executive may from time to time, either generally or particularly delegate to the Provincial Secretary or an authorised officer the powers of the Executive under this ordinance except powers specified in section 21.
- (ii) Subject to any general or specific directions given or conditions attached by the Executive, the Provincial Secretary or authorised officer may exercise those powers in the same manner and with the same effect as if they had been conferred on the Provincial Secretary or authorised officer by this section and not by delegation.
- (iii) Any delegation under this section shall be recorded and maintained by the Executive.
- (iv) Until a delegation made under this is revoked, it shall continue in force according to its tenor.
- (v) Every delegation made under this section shall be revocable at will, and no such delegation shall prevent the exercise of any power by the Executive.
