DEMONITIZATION OF CURRENCY COINS LN122 OF 2012

The Central Bank of Solomon Islands (CBSI) under powers conferred to it in section 25 (4) of the CBSI Act (Cap. 49) hereby announce that all Circulating Coins issued by the Central Bank of Solomon Islands under section 27 of the CBSI Act (Cap. 49) between 1977 and 2010 shall cease to be legal tender in Solomon Islands with effect from 31st December 2012.

The denomination, composition, dimension and design specifications of the coins are specified in the schedule:

**FOREST RESOURCES AND TIMBER UTILISATION ACT
(Cap. 40)**

Forest Resources and Timber Utilisation (Felling Licences) (Amendment) Regulations 2012.

IN exercise of the powers conferred upon me by section 44 of the Forest Resources and Timber Utilisation Act (Cap. 40), I make these Regulations –

Citation **1.** These Regulations may be cited as the Forest Resources and Timber Utilisation (Felling Licences) (Amendment) Regulations 2012.

Principal Regulations amended **2.** The Forest Resources and Timber Utilisation (Felling Licences) Regulations 2005 is amended by deleting Regulation 7(c)(ix) and replacing as follows:-

“Forest Licence Performance Bond a cash deposit of the sum of SBD250,000.00 as performance bond into the Forest Licence Performance Bond Special Fund with Central Bank of Solomon Islands”.
