SOLOMON ISLANDS INDEPENDENCE ORDER (L.N. 43 of 1978)

DIRECTION OF ASSIGNMENT OF RESPONSIBILITY

IN exercise of the powers conferred by section 37 of the Constitution and in accordance with the advice of the Prime Minister, **I, SIR FRANK UTU OFAGIORO KABUI**, Knight Grand Cross of the Most Distinguish Order of Saint Michael and Saint George, Cross of the Order of Solomon Islands, Officer of the Most Excellent Order of the British Empire, Governor-General and Commander-in-Chief of Solomon Islands, do hereby direct by assigning to the person from time to time holding the office of -

MINISTER FOR DEVELOPMENT PLANNING AND AID COORDINATION

responsibility for the administration of the Ministry of Finance and Treasury for the conduct of the business of the Government of Solomon Islands as set out in the Schedule hereunder until 25th January, 2016 or the date the Minister of Finance and Treasury resumes duty.
