JOINT REGULATION

No. 9 of
1962.

to bring into effect the Estimates of the Joint Administration in the year 1962.

MADE by the British and French Resident Commissioners under the provisions of articles 5, 7 and paragraph 2 of article 2 of the Anglo-French Protocol of 1914 and Section 5 of the Joint Finance Regulation No. 10 of 1957, after consultation with the Advisory Council and with the approval of the Governments of Her Britannic Majesty and of the French Republic.

1. This Regulation may be cited as the 1962 Appropriation Joint Regulation.
2. The Estimates of the Joint Administration for the year 1962 shall provide for—
 - (a) Revenue to the amount of Six Hundred and Thirteen Thousand Three Hundred and Fifty Pounds Sterling or One Hundred and Fifty Three Million Three Hundred and Thirty Seven Thousand Five Hundred New Hebrides Francs.
 - (b) Expenditure to the amount of Six Hundred and Thirteen Thousand Three Hundred and Fifty Pounds Sterling or One Hundred and Fifty Three Million Three Hundred and Thirty Seven Thousand Five Hundred New Hebrides Francs.
 - (c) There shall be issued from the general revenue and other funds of the Joint Administration and applied to the service of the Joint Administration ending 31st day of December 1962 a sum not exceeding that specified in (b) of Section 2 of this Joint Regulation. The said amount shall be appropriated as set out in the Schedule to this Joint Regulation.
3. The Ordonnateur shall authorise expenditure and the Treasurer shall pay such sum or sums of money as the Resident Commissioners, jointly by warrant from time to time direct for the purposes aforesaid not exceeding on the whole the sum specified in Section 2 of this Joint Regulation.
