JOINT REGULATION 2 of 1941

## A JOINT REGULATION

No. 2 of  
1941.

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Issued by the Resident Commissioners in accordance with the provisions of Article 7 of the Anglo-French Protocol of 1914.

1. Whenever it shall appear desirable to the Resident Commissioners that the boundary of any block of land or of any portion thereof should be more clearly defined or ascertained, the Resident Commissioners acting jointly, may serve or cause to be served by any person authorised by them notice on the owner or occupier of any such land requiring him within the period specified in such notice, to clear, define, or otherwise ascertain the boundary of the said land to the satisfaction of an official surveyor (or other qualified person) specified in the said notice.

2. Any person who fails to comply with the terms of any notice or who prevents or obstructs the execution of any of the terms of the said notice, issued under the provisions of this Regulation shall be guilty of an offence against this Regulation.

3. In the event of failure to comply with the terms of any notice served under this Regulation the Resident Commissioners may take or order to be taken such steps as may be required to ensure the execution of any work required by such notice, the cost of which shall be recoverable from the person concerned. Any person who prevents or obstructs the execution of any work as aforesaid shall be guilty of an offence against this Regulation.

4. Offences against this Regulation shall be punishable by a fine not exceeding £20 and imprisonment not exceeding one month or by one or other of such penalties.

5. This Regulation shall come into force on the day of the date hereof and may be cited for all purposes as "The New Hebrides Definition of Land Boundaries Regulation No. 2 of 1941".
