JOINT REGULATION 6 of 1915

A JOINT REGULATION

No. 6 of 1915.

To prohibit the importation, fabrication and sale of Absinthe in the New Hebrides.

1. From the first day of January, 1916, the manufacture, importation, circulation and sale wholesale or by retail of absinthe or similar liquors in the New Hebrides shall be prohibited.

Importation, &c., of absinthe prohibited.

2. Any contravention of the provisions of this Regulation shall be justiciable by the Joint Court and any person found guilty of such contravention shall be liable to pay a money penalty of from one to twenty pounds and to suffer imprisonment for a term of from one to thirty days or to one or other of these penalties.

Penalties for contravention.

3. This Regulation shall be known as the New Hebrides (Absinthe Prohibition) Regulation (No. 6) of 1915.
