JOINT REGULATION

No. 8 of 1972

To amend the rates of postage on articles sent by post within and beyond the New Hebrides.

[Published: Condominium Gazette No. 312, amended by Joint Regulation No. 19 of 1972 (Gazette No. 317).]

MADE by the Resident Commissioners under paragraph 2 of Article 2 and Article 7 of the Anglo-French Protocol of 1914.

1. On and after the first day of May, 1972, the following rates shall be payable for the conveyance of articles by post to places within and beyond the New Hebrides.

- (a) *Internal and preferential rates* shall apply to articles other than parcels addressed to any place within the New Hebrides, including the Banks and Torres Islands, or within Great Britain, any British Dominion, Colony, Protectorate or Mandated Territory, or within France, any French Colony, Protectorate or Mandated Territory. *International rates* shall apply to articles other than parcels addressed to any place not specified in the preceding paragraph. *General conditions* shall apply as indicated.

(c) Rates and general conditions applicable to parcels addressed to any place outside the New Hebrides will be notified by the Condominium Postmaster.

2. (a) The value in French currency of the foregoing rates shall be the amount obtained by multiplying such rates by the coefficient declared pursuant to Article 2 (a) of Joint Regulation No. 6 of 1938.

(b) The value in English and Australian currency respectively of the foregoing rates shall be the equivalent in such currencies at the official Condominium rate of exchange of the French value thereof.

3. This Joint Regulation shall come into force on the First Day of May, 1972, on which day the Postal Tariff Joint Regulation No. 4 of 1970 shall be repealed.

4. This Joint Regulation may be cited as the Joint Postal Tariff Regulation No. 8 of 1972.
