

NEW HEBRIDES CONDOMINIUM

JOINT REGULATION

No. 37 of 1976

TO AMEND the Import Duties (Consolidation) Regulation No. 52 of 1975 as amended.

MADE by the Resident Commissioners under the provisions of Articles 2:2, 5 and 7 of the Anglo-French Protocol of 1914.

1. The First Schedule to the Import Duties (Consolidation) Regulation No. 52 of 1975 (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Regulation") is hereby amended in the following manner -

(a) in the descriptions relating to Classification Numbers 89.08, 89.09, 89.10 and 89.11, by deleting the words "tons nett" and replacing them by the words "tons gorss";

(b) by adding at the end of Chapter 89, the following new classification -

89.12 Ocean-going pleasure boats
of the yacht type : kg: 10% " .

2. The proviso to paragraph (a) of Heading X-8 in the Third Schedule to the principal Regulation is hereby deleted and replaced by the following proviso -

"Provided that the full rate of customs duty will become payable upon transfer of ownership of such craft, whether for valuable consideration or not, or where it has been retained in the New Hebrides for a period or periods of six months in any period of two years, save by reason of circumstances beyond the owner's control, which shall be subject to the final decision of the Controller of Customs. " .

3. This Regulation may be cited as the Import Duties (Amendment) (no. 2) Regulation No. 37 of 1976 and shall come into operation on the date of its publication in the Condominium Gazette.
