FORESTRY ACT NO. 26 OF 2001

Forestry (Maximum Annual Quantity for Harvesting Sandalwood)
Order No. 24 of 2006

An Order to specify the maximum quantity of Sandalwood that can be harvested annually in the Islands of Efate and Aniwa.

In exercise of the powers conferred on me by paragraph 47(6)(b) of the Forestry Act No. 26 of 2001, I, Honourable MARCELLINO PIPITE, Minister responsible for Forestry, Acting on the advice of the Director General of the Ministry responsible for Forestry, make the following Order:

1 Sandalwood harvest season

(1) The species known as Santalum austro-caledonicum or otherwise commonly known as sandalwood is open for harvesting in the following Islands:

(a) Efate;


(b) Aniwa.

(2) The maximum quantity of sandalwood that is to be harvested per year is 5 tons.

3 Commencement

This Order commences on the day on which it is made.
