

REPUBLIC OF VANUATU

INTERNATIONAL TRADE (FAUNA AND FLORA) REGULATIONS

No. 2 OF 1994

To provide for the forms of permits, fees and matters connected therewith.

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred by section 19 of the International Trade (Fauna and Flora) Act No. 56 of 1989, I IOLU ABBIL, Minister of Home Affairs, make the following regulations:-

INTERPRETATION

1. In this Regulations, unless the context otherwise requires:-

"Act" means the International Trade (Fauna and Flora) Act No. 56 of 1989;

"Convention" means the Convention on International Trade in Endangered Species of Wild Fauna and Flora;

"Management Authority" means the Environment Section of the Department of Physical Planning and Environment, Ministry of Home Affairs.

FORM OF APPLICATION FOR A PERMIT

2. Every application for the grant of a permit shall be made to the Management Authority in the form set out in Schedule 1 and accompanied by a fee of VT 200.

FORM OF EXPORT PERMIT

3. An export permit granted in accordance with the provisions of section 4, 8 or 12 of the Act shall be in the form set out in Schedule 2.

FORM OF IMPORT PERMIT

4. An import permit granted under the provisions of sections 5, 9 or 13 of the Act shall be in the form set out in Schedule 3.

FORM OF RE-EXPORT PERMIT

5. A re-export permit granted under the provisions of sections 6 or 10 of the Act shall be in the form set out in Schedule 4.


FORM OF CERTIFICATE

6. Every certificate issued under the provisions of section 11(1) of the Act shall be in the form set out in Schedule 5.

COMMENCEMENT

7. These Regulations shall come into force on the date of its publication in the Gazette.
