CHAPTER 20

THE PRISONERS (RELEASE ON LICENCE)
ORDER NO. 18 OF 1998

An Order to provide for the release of Prisoner **VICTOR WONG**.

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred by section 30 of the Prisons (Administration) Act [CAP. 20], I, **FATHER WALTER HADYE LINI**, Minister of Internal Affairs and Minister responsible for prisons, **HEREBY MAKE** the following Order:-

RELEASE OF PRISONER ON LICENCE

1. **VICTOR WONG** who is currently being held in custody as a prisoner, shall be set free and be released from prison on the 24th April, 1998 **SUBJECT TO THE TERMS AND CONDITIONS** set out in sections 2 and 3 of this Order.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF RELEASE

2. The following terms and conditions shall apply -
 - (a) **VICTOR WONG** shall submit his passport and other relevant travelling documents to the authority prior to commencement of his release on licence period being from the 24th April, 1998 and ending on the 25th November, 1998 which period is hereinafter called "the relevant period".

Provided that the said documents and passport shall be returned to Victor Wong on the expiry of the relevant period.
 - (b) Victor Wong shall keep the peace and be of good behaviour during the relevant period.

- (c) In the event that **VICTOR WONG** should commit a criminal offence during the relevant period, whether or not the offence is of a similar nature as that for which **VICTOR WONG'S** original prison sentence was ordered by the Court or, the Court before which **VICTOR WONG** appears for such new offence orders a prison sentence, **VICTOR WONG** shall automatically be recalled and returned to prison.

PROCEDURES RELATING TO VIOLATIONS OF CONDITIONS OR RELEASE, RECALL TO PRISON, ETC.

3. In every case where the provisions of paragraph (c) of section 2 apply, the following procedures shall apply:-

- (a) Where the Minister is satisfied that **VICTOR WONG** has violated the terms and conditions set out in section 2, the Minister shall issue a Notice in writing directing that **VICTOR WONG** be returned to custody forthwith.
- (b) A Notice issued by the Minister shall be served on **VICTOR WONG** directing him to return to prison at such time and on such day as specified in the Notice.
- (c) **VICTOR WONG** when returned to prison in accordance with this section shall be obliged to serve the unexpired term, of his original sentence which he would have had to serve if he had not been released in accordance with this Order.
- (d) **VICTOR WONG** when returned to prison in accordance with this section is not entitled to have part of his original unexpired term of sentence remitted.

COMMISSIONER OF POLICE AND SUPERINTENDENT OF PRISONS TO ENFORCE DIRECTIONS OF THE MINISTER

4. The Commissioner of Police and the Superintendent of Prisons shall take all lawful measures required or necessary to enforce every direction or notice issued by the Minister under this Order.

COMMENCEMENT

5. This Order shall come into force on the 24th of April, 1998.
