### ROAD TRAFFIC [CONTROL] ACT [CAP 29]

#### COMPOUNDING FINE REGULATION

Order No 20 of 2007

In exercise of the powers conferred on me by subsection 46A (2), 53 (1) and 59 (b) of the Road Traffic (Control) Act [CAP 29], I, the Honorable James BULE, Acting Minister of Finance and Economic Management, make the following order.

#### **1 Interpretation**

**Act** means the Road Traffic (Control) Act [CAP 29].

#### **2 Driving Licence that has no expiry date**

- (1) A holder of a driving licence that has no expiry date must present his or her licence to the licensing authority, on or before 1<sup>st</sup> of June 2007 to be issued with a new driving licence that has a validity of 3 years.
- (2) A person who fails to comply with clause 2 is liable to pay a compound fine of VT 2,500.

#### **3 Renewal of a Driving Licence that has an expiry date**

A holder of a driving licence who has not renewed his or her driver's licence on or before the expiry of that licence is liable to pay a fine of VT 2,500.

#### **4 Compounding Notice**

A person referred to in clause 2 and 3 will be issued with a compounding notice once a police officer of the rank of inspector or above establishes the contravention.

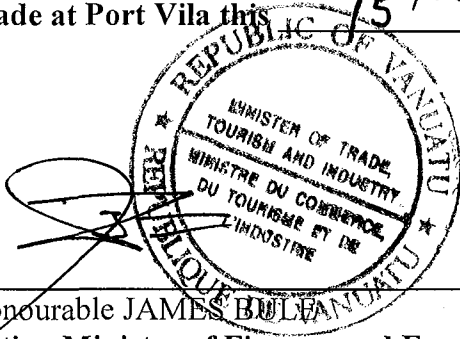
#### **5 Time of payment**

The person referred to in clause 2 and 3 must pay the compounding fine within 2 days from the date on which he or she is served with the compounding notice.

#### **6 Commencement**

This Order commences on the date on which it is published in the Gazette.
