VU les pouvoirs que lui confère l'article 19 de la loi sur la vente des boissons alcoolisées (CAP. 52).

A R R E T E :

LA VENTE DES BOISSONS ALCOOLISEES EST INTERDITE DANS LES PROVINCES DES BANKS/TORRES, AMBRYM, PAAMA, EPI ET DANS LA REGION MUNICIPALE DE LUGANVILLE

1. Sous réserve de l'article 2, la vente et la distribution des boissons alcoolisées dans les débits de boissons situés dans les Provinces des Banks/Torres, Ambrym, Paama, Epi et dans le périmètre municipal de Luganville soit pour consommer sur place ou pour emporter, est par les présentes interdite entre 7h30 du matin le mercredi 23 janvier 1991 et minuit le jeudi 24 janvier 1991.

DEROGATION

2. Nonobstant les dispositions de l'article 1, les restaurants et les hôtels pourront vendre des boissons alcoolisées durant ladite période au cours de leurs heures normales d'ouverture aux clients qui en commandent de bonne foi pour accompagner leur repas.

Le présent arrêté entrera en vigueur le 23 janvier 1991.

REGULATIONS No. 3 OF 1991

To amend the Civil Aviation (Air Navigation) Regulation No. 21 of 1988.

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred by section 3(1) paragraph (q) of the Civil Aviation Act [CAP. 159], I hereby make the following regulation:

AMENDMENT OF REGULATION No. 21 OF 1988

1. The Civil Aviation (Air Navigation) Regulations No. 21 of 1988 is amended in regulation 1(1), by deleting the figure "VT 10" and substituting the figure "VT 20".

COMMENCEMENT

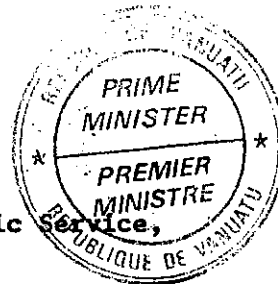

THE CIVIL AVIATION (AIRCRAFT LANDING FEES) (REGULATIONS)
(AMENDMENT) ORDER NO. 4 OF 1991

An Order to amend the Civil Aviation (Aircraft Landing Fees Regulations) Order No. 43 of 1984.

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred by section 3 (1) (r) of the Civil Aviation Act [CAP. 159], I, WALTER H LINI, Prime Minister and Minister of Public Service, Planning, Civil Aviation, Energy and Fisheries make the following regulations :-

AMENDMENT OF REGULATION 2 OF ORDER NO. 43 OF 1984

1. The Civil Aviation (Aircraft Landing Fees Regulation) Order No. 43 of 1984 in this Order referred to as the "principal Order", is amended in regulation 2 -

(a) by deleting paragraph (i) and substituting the following paragraph :-

"(i) not exceeding 20 tonnes VT 350;"

(b) by deleting paragraph (ii) and substituting the following paragraph :-

"(ii) exceeding 20 tonnes
but not exceeding 60 tonnes VT 485;"

AMENDMENT OF REGULATION 3 OF THE PRINCIPAL ORDER

2. The principal Order is amended -

(a) in regulation 3 (a) by deleting paragraph (i) and substituting the following paragraph :-

"(i) for the first 15 tonnes VT 100;"

(b) in regulation 3 (b) by deleting the figure "VT 100" and substituting the figure "VT 200".

COMMENCEMENT

3. This Order shall come into force on the day of its publication in the Gazette.
