# RESERVE BANK OF VANUATU

## **Nautilus International Bank Limited**

On the 21<sup>st</sup> October 2005, the Reserve Bank of Vanuatu, pursuant to section 13 of the International Banking Act No. 4 of 2002, issued a directive to Nautilus International Bank Limited, requiring it to respond to a number of issues identified by the Reserve Bank of Vanuatu including the need to maintain its banking business records in Vanuatu, modify shortcomings in its Risk Management policies and procedures and reducing its largest exposure to B.W.P Investments Consulting Ltd to comply with the exposure requirement. The Reserve Bank of Vanuatu has directed that Nautilus International Bank Limited respond to these issues by 18 November 2005.
