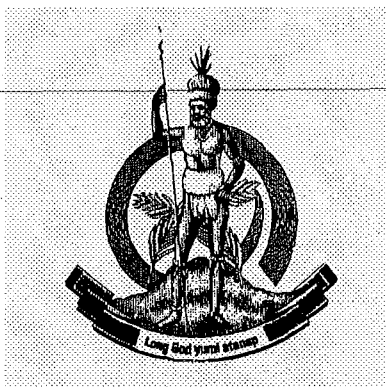

Instrument of Extension of Period of Suspension of the Exercise of the Powers of the Port Vila Municipal Council Order No. 23 of 2008

In exercise of the powers conferred on me by paragraph 61(3)(a) of the Municipalities Act [CAP 126] and subclause 1(3) of the Instrument of Suspension of the Exercise of the Powers of the Port Vila Municipal Council Order No. 5 of 2008, I, the Honourable JOE NATUMAN Minister of Internal Affairs make the following Order:

1 Extension of the period of suspension of the exercise of the powers of the Port Vila Municipal Council

The period of suspension of the exercise of the powers of the Port Vila Municipal Council is extended for a further period of 6 months from the date on which this Order takes effect.

2 Commencement

This Order is taken to have commenced on the 18th of May 2008.


