THE BEETLE ORDINANCE AMENDMENT ORDINANCE, 1921.

Western Samoa.

No. 9, 1921.



An Ordinance

made by the Administrator of the Territory of Western Samoa with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council of that Territory, and in pursuance of the Samoa Constitution Order, 1920.

1. This Ordinance may be cited as "The Beetle Ordinance Amendment Ordinance, 1921."

2. Clause 21 of The Beetle Ordinance, 1921, is hereby repealed and the following clause is enacted in lieu thereof:

- 21 (a) All exemption fees derived from any village shall be paid back for the benefit of such village to the Pulenuu of such village.
- (b) The Administrator may in his discretion as a reward for efficiency in carrying out the provisions of this Ordinance direct the payment by the Treasurer of such sum or sums as he may think fit out of the total fines derived under clause 20 hereof from all villages in Samoa to the Pulenuu or Pulenuus of any village or villages which the Administrator deems to have deserved to be so rewarded.
